SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CITING/REFEREE'S REPORT/INCIDENT FOOTAGE

Players disciplinary record

An incident took place at 78 minutes into the game. Referee stopped play and was told by the assistant that Turkey No.8 had kicked a Serbian player whilst they were in the ground in the course of a ruck. The referee issued a red card to Turkey No.8. Subsequently, when reviewing the match after it had finished the referee satisfied himself that in fact the player who he would have sent off on the basis of the assistant's report was the Turkey No.6 i.e.

Yasin Akgul now subject to these proceedings. The video clips show that the Player did kick the Serbian No.8 in the head.

There is no evidence from the assistant or any of the Serbian players. There is no evidence that the Serbian player was injured as a result of the incident. What happened had no material impact on the outcome of the game.

SUMMARY OF PLAYER'S EVIDENCE

The Player accepted that he had offended against the laws of rugby. He stated that he was frustrated as his team were losing and he also believed another player was holding him. He accepted that he kicked out at the player on the floor and that his foot made contact with his head/face. The player stated that he regretted his action and said after the match he apologised to the other players and coaches for his conduct.

FINDINGS OF FACT

On the basis of the video evidence and the Player's admissions we concluded that he was guilty of an offence contrary to Law 9.12, physical abuse by kicking.
