The Player denied punching an opponent. In his evidence he minimised his conduct, which included pulling at opponent and briefly pulling an opponent across the throat area.

### Findings of fact

The video footage conclusively showed that at no time did the Player punch or strike an opponent. The reverse camera angle showed that the movement of the Player's arm was not a strike or punch.



The officials did not give evidence and their account could not be tested or explored.

Accordingly, the Referee was wrong to send the Player off. The Player committed foul play by his dangerous conduct pulling at opponents for which a Yellow Card is substituted in the place of the Red Card.
