

4. Hearing Notification

The following procedure for the disciplinary hearings in case of Foul Play shall be applied by the Chairperson of the designated Disciplinary Panel, or where applicable the Judicial Officer, who is entitled to give any directions necessary for the proper conduct of proceedings generally including, but not limited to:

- a) Establish the date, time, set-up and place of the hearing;
- b) Notify the Player and his/her Union of the date, time and place of the hearing;

- c) Advise the Player of the Panel Members' identity, and any other person(s) in attendance where relevant;
- d) Provide the cited Player with all relevant reports and evidence against him/her;
- e) Inform the Player that he/she is entitled to make written submissions in advance of the hearing;
- f) Inform the Player that he/she can be represented by his/her Union and/or a legal advisor;
- g) Remind the Player that he/she cannot play any Match pending resolution of the case.

Shall the cited Player be not available and unable to attend the meeting, he/she must inform the Disciplinary Panel at the earliest opportunity. Where a Player cited fails to attend a hearing, the Disciplinary Panel has the discretion to adjourn the hearing or, where it is satisfied that there are no reasonable grounds for the failure to attend, to proceed to hear the case against the Player cited; or to suspend the Person Charged until such time as he/she appears.

If you wish to submit some elements in writing before the hearing, please feel free to use the "Disciplinary Statement" form. It will be shared with The Disciplinary Panel as soon as practicable.

Please note that this Hearing Notification also serves as Disciplinary Notice and formally marks the beginning of the Disciplinary Case.

Please give a detailed report below (PLEASE WRITE CLEARLY): The alleged foul play occurred as the Hungarian #9 was carrying the ball in across the front of her posts approximately 8 meters from the Hungarian try line. Moldova #3 was in sight of the ball carrier, in an upright position for the tackle and resulted with her outstretched left arm making contact to the ball carriers chin and neck area resulting in the Hungarian 9 going to ground immediately. The incident was detected by the Referee who stopped play and issued a Yellow Card to Moldova #3. After the Hungarian player was attended to by her medical staff briefly, she continued in the match and play resumed with a penalty to Hungary.			
The action of Moldova #3 resulted in direct contact to the head area of the Hungarian player, was reckless & avoidable with a high level of force (as demonstrated by the speed the Hungarian player went to ground). Upon review of the video, I deem that the player had a clear line of sight of the ball carrier, there was no significant changes in height or movement and that the tackler was in an upright position through the tackle.			
I believe that the actions of Moldova #3 in using her outstretched arm resulting in a direct contact to the head and neck area of the ball carrier & with a high degree of danger posed a significant risk of serious injury to the Hungarian #9 and that this constitutes a dangerous tackle contrary to Law 9.13.
