SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CITING/REFEREE'S REPORT/INCIDENT FOOTAGE

The Referee's Report stated that:

At the second half, 5th minutes, Player n.2 of the Andorra Team, Adria Casals Moline "*Kicking the ball from the hands of ball-carrier. Kicking the ball carrier after the try.* The video footage shows clearly the incident of the referee report.

SUMMARY OF PLAYER'S EVIDENCE

The Player accepted the content of the Referee Report and that he committed an act of foul play, and that it was worth a red card.

He stated that he not intended to hit not to hurt the player.

In any case he confirmed that there was a contact with the ball that was in the hands of the ball carrier and that the contact occurred after that the Switzerland player scored the try.

The Andorra player accepted that his act was worth a red card, even if he did not have the intention to hurt or injury the ball carrier.

He was sorry and after the game he went to speak to the Switzerland player to clarify and apologize.

The player is young and has an unblemished disciplinary record.

FINDINGS OF FACT

No preliminary points arose.

The Player confirmed to have received:

- Notice of Disciplinary hearing;

- Referee report;

- video footage of the incident;

- Disciplinary Statement.

The video of the incident from two different angles was seen at the hearing.

The Andorra Rugby Federation was represented at the hearing by the Andorra team manager.

The Player confirmed that he was the Player involved in the referee report and that there was a foul play.

The standard of proof for all matters under this Regulation 17 is on the balance of probabilities.

When the Player does not accept that the act(s) of Foul Play which is the subject of the disciplinary hearing warranted the Player being Ordered Off or cited, the burden of proof rests on the Player to show that the referee/citing commissioner was wrong.

The Player tried to justify his conduct saying that he had no intention to hurt or injury the Switzerland player, but the images of the incident show that the player actually kicked the ball from the hands of the ball carrier, while the ball carrier was lying on the ground after the try and that such act should be considered as dangerous.

At the end, the player accepted that there was a foul play, reckless, and that it was worth a red card.

The Judicial Officer found, on the balance of probabilities, that the Andorra Player n.2 Adria Casals Moline kicked the ball from the hands of the ball carrier after the try and that such conduct have to be considered dangerous under Rugby Europe Regulations and World Rugby Regulation 17 appendix 2.

The images of the incident were clear and show the whole incident.

The player accepted that there was foul play which merited a red card, and therefore the red card was confirmed.
