Although the player states his intentions with the chosen way of tackling – tackling below the shoulders, grabbing the arms to smother any passing –, that does not necessarily make them intentionally dangerous. They are at least persistently reckless.

Where a Player[.] has received over a Match two yellow cards; or a combination of one yellow card and one Citing Commissioner Warning; the designated Judicial Officer is required to apply a sanction for the offence of persistent offending, not for the substantive offences relating to each yellow card and/or Citing Commissioner Warning.
